 - 1. God is the only Source of all material blessings enjoyed by every human, James 1:17; Matthew 5:45; Job 12:10.
 - 2. Most humans hurt God by refusing to acknowledge His provision, Romans 1:21; Jeremiah 9:3; Luke 17:17-18; Psalm 28:5.
 - 3. Acknowledging God by giving blesses Him greatly.
 - B. Giving demonstrates your love for the object of God's love.
 - 1. The object of God's love—the church, Ephesians 5:25; Acts 20:28; Matthew 16:18.
 - 2. Giving to the church shows our "oneness" with God's love, Mark 12:43-44.
 - 3. Adopting God's love as our love blesses Him greatly.
 - C. Giving to God permits Him to give additional material blessings to you.
 - 1. Trustworthiness permits God to give additional material blessings, Luke 16:10; Proverbs 3:9-10; Malachi 3:10; Luke 6:38.
 - 2. Givers always receive the greatest blessing, Acts 20:35.
 - 3. Giving to us rejoices God's heart, Zephaniah 3:17.
