 3. Faith ignores the "walls" appearing erect, 2 Corinthians 4:18; Mark 5:36, 39-40.
 4. Praise is the lang. faith speaks, Romans 4:19-20; Joshua 6:16; Acts 16:25.
 - B. Hope in human ability fades away.
 1. When filled with hope in human ability, no room for faith in God.
 2. Viewing Jericho's walls emptied Israel of hope in self.
 3. Praise destroys discouragement over human inability and fills us with hope in God, Isaiah 49:23; Psalm 25:5, 21 & 31:24.
 4. Praise is the language hope in God speaks, Joshua 6:5, 20.
 - C. When you can't sense God's presence.
 1. Praise—a response to God's nearness, Revelation 5:11-13.
 2. Concentrating on "walls" destroys a sense of God's nearness, Psalm 22:1.
 3. Praise is an act of faith which brings God's presence, Acts 16:26 & 4:31; Joshua 6:20.
