 1. Terror – first normal reaction, Exodus14:10.
 2. Terrified – unresisted, abnormal fear that destroys faith in God, Exodus 14:11, 12.
 3. They became "terrorized" – shaken, to pieces by life's upheavals.
 4. Through God's power, choose to "not fear," John 14:1, 27; Isaiah12:2.
 5. Feel the fear but continue trusting, Psalm 56:3, Ezra3:3; 2 Corinthians 7:5.
 - B. Stand firm in your faith, Exodus 14:13. (Stand – continue, remain, security, solidity, fixed in place; not weak or uncertain).
 1. Upheavals attempt to knock us off our feet.
 2. Then, we can't go on with life, Exodus14:11, 12.
 3. Moses commanded the people to believe they could stand firm – you don't need Egypt.
 4. God's powerful strength dwells in us, Luke10:19; Ephesians3:20.
 5. "Standing firm" means you believe in what God says you are and can do, Ephesians 6:13.
 6. Choose to be "unshaken," 1 Corinthians 15:58. (Move—dislodge, displace from a fixed position; shake, tremble).
