Genesis 17:1-2, 15-17

- I. "When Abram was 99 yrs. old the Lord...said...‘I will greatly increase your numbers,’” Genesis 17:1.
- II. "As for...your wife...I will surely give you a son by her," Genesis 17:15-16.
- III. "Abraham...laughed & said to himself," Genesis 17:17.
 - A. Why did he laugh? Why did he ask himself questions?
 - B. He was battling to believe God’s promises!
- IV. Win your battle to believe!
 - A. Refuse to condemn yourself for battling.
 1. Condemn—to pronounce to be utterly wrong; blame; reject one’s conduct; to judge self unfit. Latin—to disapprove or doom.
 2. Jesus’ battle, Mark 14:33-36.
 3. Don’t condemn self; pride self because you’re in the battle—you haven’t given up!
 4. God always helps warriors—never gives up on them, Genesis 17:21-22; Psalm 145:14&146:8; Romans 4:20.
 5. Don’t fear the battle: It’s part of winning the war, Ezra 3:3; Psalm 94:18-19; 2 Corinthians 7:5-6
 - B. Quit trying to fit God’s promise into your mind.
 1. Abram’s opponent – effort to comprehend God’s promise, Genesis 17:5.
 2. God can only give God-sized promises.
 3. We are human-sized.
 4. So, quit trying to comprehend & accept His incomprehensible promises; Proverbs 3:5; Ezekiel 37:3.
