 1. "Assume" take without proof, fact, or evidence; believe only appearances.
 2. Proverbs 18:13 L.B. "What a shame – yes, how stupid! – to decide before knowing the facts!
 3. The enemy's actual thoughts, Joshua 2:10-11; James 2:19.
 4. Say "no" to guess work.
 5. Say "yes" to the knowledge God gives, Proverbs 2:6; Numbers 14:3, 9.
 - B. Silence your fearful thoughts, Numbers 13:30.
 1. Fear shouts, "Disaster awaits you," Numbers 14:1-3.
 2. By shouting, fear drowns out God's Word.
 3. You can't always prevent fear, 2 Corinthians 7:5.
 4. So, we must silence fear.
 5. Accept God's help against fear: 80 commands to "fear not."
 6. Say "no" to noisy fear, II Timothy 1:7, Psalm 56:3; John 14:1; Deuteronomy 20:1.
 - C. Look for victory in the right place.
 1. Barnea barriers block our view of future victory.
 2. Ignore the future & look to your past victories, Deuteronomy 1:29-31.
