 - 1. Peace of mind depends on what is within you, not what is around you, Acts 12:5-7, 1Samuel 17:24, 32.
 - 2. God and His peace dwell in you, Psalm 29:11, Philippians 4:7, Acts 28:3-5.
 - B. My promises plant unconquerable peace within you, Psalm 119:165, Isaiah 48:18.
 - 1. We release God's indwelling peace by deliberately choosing to believe His promises, Psalm 3:5-6, Numbers, 14:1-3, 7-9.
 - 2. God shields the minds of those who quit trying to "figure things out," Isaiah 26:3.
 - C. The indwelling Holy Spirit returns the "power of choice to you," Galatians 5:22-23.
 - 1. Colossians 3:15. "Let" means to "allow or permit," John 14:1, 27.
 - 2. We believe in indwelling peace and our power of choice. Armed with these two, we choose peace of mind, 2 Chronicles 20:12.
