 - 1. Self-control—the ability to focus your thoughts upon God, 2 Chronicles 20:12.
 - 2. Holy Spirit’s abilities imparted during fellowship time, Exodus 34:29-30; Mark 9:23; 14:35, 42.
- B. Pursue a victor’s memory.
 - 1. Not locked into a loser’s memory, Philippians 3:13; Isaiah 43:18.
 - 2. Believers inherit a new history: become one with victorious spiritual ancestors, Galatians 3:7; 2 Corinthians 5:17.
- C. Permeate your memory with the believer’s history book, Joshua 1:8; Psalm 143:5.
 - 1. Records the history of God’s victorious people, Hebrews 11.
 - 2. This history predicts our future victories, Romans 15:4; Hebrews 13:8.
